PRESS NOTE (for the week from 24.08.2025 to 30.08.2025)

Cyberabad Women & Children Safety Wing continues its dedicated efforts to ensure the safety, protection and wellbeing of women and children within its jurisdiction.

During this week i.e. from 24.08.2025 to 30.08.2025, the SHE Teams of Cyberabad have conducted 152 decoy operations and 45 persons were caught red-handed while indulging in indecent acts at public places. Petty cases were booked in all 45 cases and Counselling sessions were held for all the respondents. The SHE Teams also received 15 complaints from women victims through various modes. As part of preventive and awareness measures, 69 awareness programs were conducted at different locations and 4 counselling sessions were organized at the Women & Children Safety Wing, Cyberabad.

In Family Counselling Centre / CDEW Centre, about 23 families were counselled in wife and husband family disputes and efforts were made to reunite them.

The Anti Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU) of Cyberabad has conducted awareness programs across various locations in Cyberabad and around 125 members participated, who were given awareness on Human trafficking and (Child Trafficking), eve teasing, Social media harassment, Child Marriages, Child Rights, Child labour, Stalking, Begging, Cyber bullying, Cyber frauds etc., Women help line 181, Child help line 1098, Dial 100 importance, Crimes 1930 and others topics etc. During this week, the team conducted raids during night time in the limits of Police Stations Narsingi, Rajendranagar, Sanathnagar, Madhapur, etc. and rescued 13 Transgenders and two women who are indulging in prostitution.

Suraksha Kavach Program

It is a comprehensive school safety initiative focused on four key pillars: Physical Safety, Cyber Safety, Psychological Safety, and Road & Infrastructure Safety. This week marked significant progress in community and school safety initiatives.

The Suraksha Kavach program has been launched in international school Shri Ram Academy aiming to foster greater sensitivity and awareness among students.





DCP Smt. Srujana has conducted a meeting with SSC School Association at Lingampally and discussed expanding Suraksha Kavach initiative to over 100 schools taking the program deeper into the community.
