



77th Republic Day Celebrations Held Grandly in Cyberabad



Cyberabad: The 77th Republic Day celebrations were held with great fervor today, 26.01.2026, at the Cyberabad Police Commissionerate. On this occasion, Cyberabad Police Commissioner Dr. M. Ramesh, IPS, unfurled the national flag and paid rich tributes by garlanding the portraits of freedom fighters.

Addressing the gathering, the CP extended Republic Day greetings to the police personnel. He recalled the historic moment of the Indian national flag being hoisted at the Red Fort in Delhi on August 15, 1947. He further explained that India adopted its Constitution on November 26, 1949, transforming into a Sovereign, Socialist, Secular, and Democratic Republic, with the Constitution coming into effect from January 26, 1950.

The CP stated that it is because of the Indian Constitution that every citizen enjoys fundamental rights. He noted that all constitutional positions are held by representatives elected by the people, which serves as the foundation of democracy. He emphasized that police personnel also perform their duties within constitutional limits. He credited the Constitution for providing rights such as empowerment of marginalized sections and women, including the right to vote. The CP pointed out that while political instability and rebellions are seen in several countries across Asia, Africa, and Europe, India remains secure primarily due to its strong Constitution. He added that the Supreme Court and the judiciary are safeguarding the Constitution and protecting the rights of the people.
