



Arrive Alive initiative gains momentum in Cyberabad



The Arrive Alive 2026 initiative took a step forward with the launch of the Arrive Alive 2026 tabletop calendar, signalling the transition from vision to action through a mission-mode roadmap for road safety in Telangana. The programme is being advanced under the leadership of Director General of Police B. Shivadhar Reddy, with support from senior police leadership across the State.

As part of the campaign, representatives of Arrive Alive met Cyberabad Commissioner of Police Dr. M. Ramesh, IPS, and Jt. CP Dr. Gajaraao Bhupal, IPS., on Monday. The interaction focused on strengthening technology-led interventions and collaborative approaches to improve road safety outcomes.

A key highlight of the visit was a test ride conducted by the CP Cyberabad in the AI-enabled Traffic Law Compliance Vehicle (TLCV), which is designed to assist enforcement agencies in monitoring traffic violations and enhancing public safety. Arrive Alive, the organisers said, is not merely a campaign but a commitment to families and to saving lives, reflecting Telangana's resolve to make road safety a shared responsibility.
