ARREST OF HABITUAL HOUSE BURGLARY OFFENDERS NABBED BY

Acting on specific information, today i.e. 24.04.2026 the sleuths of Miyapur Police, Kukatpally Zone, Cyberabad Commissionerate nabbed the Notorious & Habitual House Burglary Offender by name Vallepu Venkatesh @ Venkat and seized the stolen 4 grams of gold ornaments, 600 grams of silver articles, one motorcycle, all W/Rs.3.5 lakhs.

PREVIOUS HISTORY OF THE ACCUSED:

MODUS OPERANDI OF ACCUSED:

The accused would move around residential colonies and identify apartments, particularly targeting watchman quarters or houses that were left unlocked. He would observe the movement of residents and wait for an opportunity when the occupants were absent. He would then enter the premises and commit theft, stealing gold and silver ornaments and cash. After committing the offence, he would leave the scene and flee.

Apprehension:

On. 24.04.2026 at morning hours the accused was while moving in the Mayurinagar area on his Activa scooter with the intention of committing theft. Meanwhile, the crime patrolling staff identified and apprehended him. During enquiry, he voluntarily confessed to his involvement, and based on his confession, the case property was recovered.

1. Gold Ornaments-4 grams

2. Silver Ornaments-607 grams 3
3. Activa Bike
